Please note the daily limit for dial-up connections is four hours per user. Technical reasons prohibit us from making individual changes to this time limit.

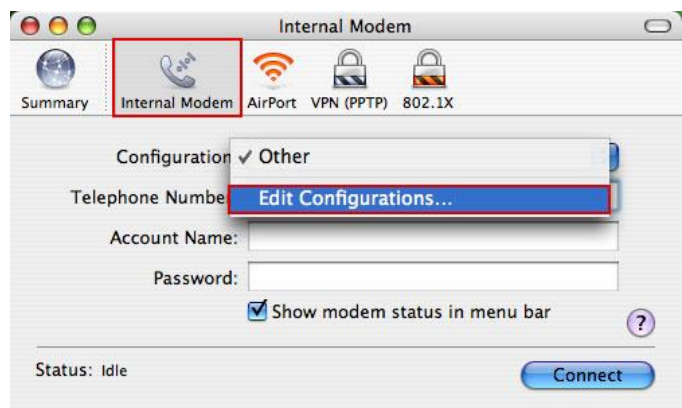
While you are connected, the HWS network may automatically disconnect you if you are not using the Internet to give other users an opportunity to connect.

To configure your computer for HWS dial-up:

1. Double-click the **hard drive icon**
2. In Applications, double-click **Internet Connect**



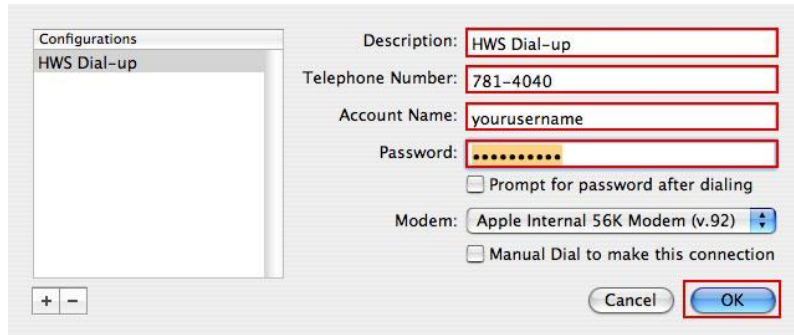
3. In Internet Connect, click **Internal Modem**
4. Click **Edit Configurations**

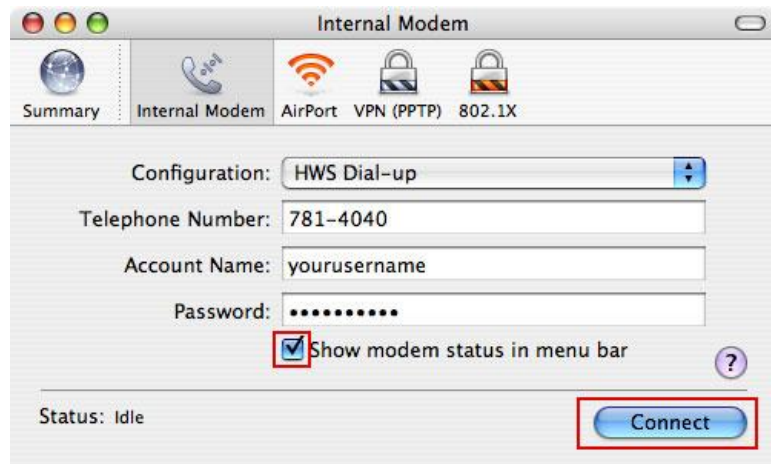
5. Enter the following:
 - Description: **HWS Dial-up**
 - Telephone Number: **781-4040**
 - Account Name: **your HWS username**
 - Password: **your HWS password**



6. Click **OK**
7. Check **Show modem status in menu bar**

A telephone receiver icon will be placed in the menu bar.

8. Click **Connect**



To Use HWS Dial-up:

1. On the menu bar, near the AirPort icon, click the **telephone receiver icon**
2. Click **Connect**
